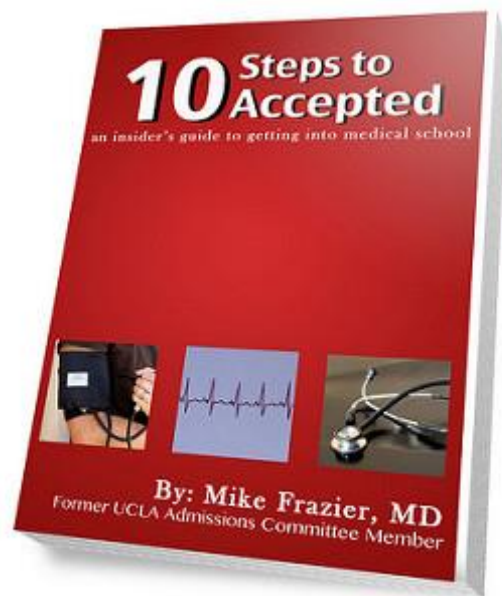

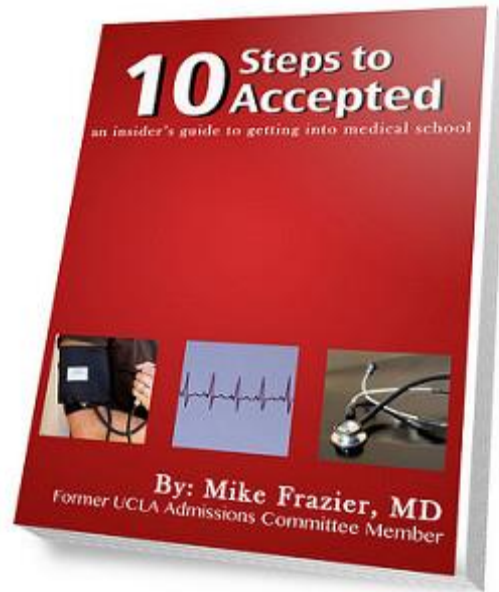
The US World and News Report stops here in ranking schools according to research. So, you get the top 88 medical schools, not quite the top 100 medical schools.
